



## USER CHOICE FOR APPRENTICESHIPS AND TRAINEESHIPS

### OVERVIEW

The User Choice program provides a public funding contribution towards the cost of training and assessment for eligible Queensland apprentices and trainees.

### ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for a government contribution towards the costs of training, an apprentice or trainee must have entered into a training contract for a qualification that is funded by DET and be registered in DET's registration system DELTA.

The government contribution for a User Choice funding contribution is detailed in the apprentice or trainee's letter of registration from DET.

Apprentices and trainees can only receive one government contribution for a User Choice funded qualification at any single point in time, i.e. a student is not funded to undertake two apprenticeships or traineeships at the same time.

In addition, apprentices and trainees can only receive a maximum of two government funding contributions under the current User Choice Program.

### COST

Students are required to pay a co-contribution fee currently \$1.60 per nominal hour of training to determine the cost of your course. Please contact Australian Academy for more details. An invoice is raised and presented at the first visit by the trainer and payment plans are agreed at that time.
